Dear KBNC Parents and Players,

Trusting you have all had a wonderful Christmas break and are looking forward to the year ahead. With the netball season for 2010 almost upon us, it is time to start thinking 'netball' again.

Please note, your **KBNC Registration Form AND fees, as well as the Parent/Player Agreement Form** must be returned together, by Friday 29th January 2009 to secure your place in a KBNC team. If your Registration Form (and payment) are not returned by this date, we will assume that you (or your daughter) are NOT intending to play for KBNC in Season 2010. Registration forms will not be accepted without payment of fees. Late registrations will only be accepted if vacancies exist within teams

KBNC prides itself on having a very high standard of acceptable behaviour. Therefore, the **Parent/Player Agreement forms** have been designed to outline both the parents' and players' accepted behaviour standards and responsibilities in order to eliminate potential problems. This form must be signed and returned along with your registration form and payment in order to process your registration. Please keep a copy of the Parent/Player Agreement for your records.

***Selling Chocolates:** to assist families with lower fees, KBNC gives families the option to reduce their fees by \$20 per player, by selling a box of chocolates. Please note that if the option to sell chocolates is chosen, then a box of chocolates is required to be sold per player and not per family.

Further, it is the responsibility of each player (family) to sell the entire box of chocolates. Partially sold boxes of chocolates cannot be returned. Remember, the selling of chocolates is not a fundraiser for the club, but rather an opportunity for players to reduce their registration fees.

Team Coaches: do you like: children; enjoy netball; and are keen to develop yours and others netball skills? Perhaps coaching a KBNC team this season is just for you. Our club subsidises the costs of all Queensland Netball approved coaching courses and our KBNC Coaching Coordinator, Paula Sale, is always 'on hand' to support you either at training or during her specially designed coaching clinics. Intermediate and senior level players are also encouraged to be a Team Coach or an Assistant Team Coach. Please contact Paula Sale (KBNC Coaching Convener) on 3374 4047 for a Team Coach Position Description. All KBNC Team Coaches will receive full training and support as well as a KBNC Volunteer's shirt to keep (if they do not already have one).

Team Managers: the role of the Team Manager is to assist the Team Coach in the capacity of undertaking the administrative duties for the team. If you think you might be interested in becoming a Team Manager, please contact Angela Leth, for a Team Manager's Position Description, which outlines the expectations of this vital position within your team.

Club Chaplains: The KBNC Chaplains serve an important role within our club in assisting and supporting our: players; parents; coaches; and coordinators. KBNC Club Chaplains do not need to belong to the Kenmore Baptist Church; however, they must subscribe to and comply with the teachings and beliefs of the Christian faith. If you would like more information on becoming a KBNC Club Chaplain, please contact Angela Leth, for a Position Description, which outlines the expectations of this vital position within your club. KBNC Club Chaplains receive a KBNC Volunteer's shirt to keep (if they do not already have one).

Age Coordinators: The role of the Age Coordinator is to oversee a particular age group of teams. The Age Coordinator works together with the particular age group's Team Coaches; Team Managers and Club Chaplains. If you would like more information of the role of the KBNC Age Coordinator, please contact Angela Leth, for a Position Description, which outlines the expectations of this vital position within your club. KBNC Club Age Coordinators receive a KBNC Volunteer's shirt to keep (if they do not already have one).

Umpire Support Volunteers: since their introduction in 2009, the KBNC Umpire Support Volunteers have been invaluable in supporting our new umpires. Requirements of this position are just a keenness to be supportive; you do not need to be an umpire yourself. All KBNC Umpire Support Volunteers will receive full training as well as a KBNC Volunteer club shirt to keep (if they do not already have one). For more information contact Angela Leth, for a Position Description, which outlines the expectations of this rewarding role.

KBNC Team Selection Procedure and Policy

The main aims of the KBNC are to ensure that every player: *enjoys* the game; and *improves* their netball skills – both of these outcomes are largely dependant upon a player playing in the correct division appropriate to their skill level.

Thus, whilst many players may wish to play in the same team with their friends, we are mindful that no two players (friends) necessarily have the same skill level, so that the keeping of friends together in the same team can compromise the Club's purpose of ensuring: game enjoyment and skill improvement.

- **KBNC Netta players: born 2002 and 2003 (note Netta is now for players turning 7 or 8 years of age in 2010) are selected on:**
 - friendship requests; and
 - player age.
- **All other KBNC Teams (including 9 year olds born 2001 who are now playing full netball rules) are selected on:**
 - the individual player's netball ability, as demonstrated during the KBNC Team Selection days, and
 - in conjunction with Season 2009 Coach's Player Reports
- **Attendance at the KBNC Team Selection trials is compulsory.** In the event that a player is unable to attend one or both of the KBNC Team Selection days, due to illness or other extenuating circumstances, prior contact must be made to the KBNC Secretary, Angela Leth on either 3378 3595 or 0438 789 875 outlining the circumstances. Players unable to attend the KBNC Team Selection days will be placed in an as appropriate team as possible, but priority will be given to players attending the Team Selection days. **NO CHANGES** to the teams will be made at the request of either the players or parents.
- Please be mindful that sometimes players (and even parents) can be disappointed with the team selections made at the beginning of the season because they have been selected in a team with lots of 'new' faces or at a division lower than anticipated. However, most players actually enjoy making new friendships and have a wonderful season of netball after all. The anxious anticipation of playing in a new team is very quickly outweighed by a player playing an entire season in a team where the standard of play is considerably above or below that of their own. Please, as parents, can I encourage you to support our club's team selection policy, which is a carefully considered process? Be assured, that your child's best interests are our primary concern.

KBNC Junior Team Selection Trials

When: Sunday 7th (and Sunday 14th February if required – times advised on Sunday 7th)

Where: William Faulkner Oval, Waratah Avenue, Graceville

Time: 2:15pm – 6:00pm

Who: Compulsory attendance for all 13s (born 1997) and 14s (born 1996) who are required to attend a KBNC Umpire training session prior to the commencement of the Team Selection games. The 13s will be responsible for umpiring the 10s, 12s and 14s from 4:15 to 6:00pm, which immediately follow their selection trials from 2:45 to 4:30pm.

The 14s will be responsible for umpiring the 9s, 11s and 13s from 2:45 to 4:30pm, prior to their selection trials from 4:30 to 6:00pm.

Please bring a finger whistle (available at sports stores) and a hair scrunchie/elastic.

Time: 2:45pm – 4:30pm

Who: Players: 9s (born 2001) 11s (born 1999)

Time: 4:15pm – 6:00pm

Who: Players: 10s (born 2000) & 12s (born 1998)

KBNC Intermediate/Senior Team Selection

When: Thursday 11th (and Thursday 18th February if required)

Where: William Faulkner Oval, Waratah Avenue, Graceville

Who: Intermediates (born 1995, 1994 and 1993) and Seniors (1992 and before)

Time: 5:45pm to 7:30pm

What to bring: suitable clothing and footwear to play netball; plenty of water; and a positive attitude.

Important notes and reminders for the Team Selection days

- 1. Under no circumstances** will Registration Forms and payment **will not be accepted** at Team Selection Trials.
- 2.** No jewellery is to be worn
- 3.** Players do not receive equal court time. Where no question of the suitability of a player into a particular division exists, a player will have less court time than a player where divisional placement is less certain;

4. Some age groups may be required for the 2nd Team Selection Day (14th February). All parents/players will notified of this requirement at the end of the selection session on 7th February. If unsure if you are required for the 14th, please double check before you leave.
5. Our Team Selectors are a dedicated group of volunteers who endeavour to do the very best for all our girls. Given that our club is one of the largest in the Brisbane area, this process is quite involved and very intensive. Please be patient during the Team Selection days, remembering that the selectors will have many more hours' work, after you have gone home.
6. Please be respectful of the decisions made by the Team Selectors, bearing in mind that we have many girls to observe. Sometimes selection decisions may not be popular and dare say, even wrong, albeit, presumably only be by one division. However, as I always maintain; if a miscalculation in a selection is the worst thing that your child or you experiences in 2010 then you are destined for a wonderful year ahead. We thank you for your anticipated acceptance of the team selection decisions made.
7. All players will be notified by email (read-receipt) as soon as practicable after Monday 22nd February. If you have not received an email by Wednesday 24th February, please email Angela Leth (KBNC Secretary) on angela. leth@kbc.org.au but not before.
8. Attendance is compulsory unless extenuating circumstances, such as illness exist. Prior notification of non attendance must be made via contacting Angela Leth (KBNC Secretary) on 3378 3595 or Sandy Fuller (KBNC President) on 0434 146 023.
